## up to 1984

- 1951: Laila's hand-painted cover for birth announcement. Note the connected "L's"
- 1959: block print by Lloyd Ames based on my design: nativity scene, in Teal.
- 1960: block print by Lloyd of my design: star-light in green
- 1967: we moved to Arizona. My first block print: 3 colors; difficult to align!
- 1972: xerographic copy of my calligraphy
- 1973: no card? First year at grad-school; drove Wisc. to Ariz. over Xmas break.
- 1974: 3-color block-print; tricky to align
- 1975: 2-color block print. various color schemes tried.
- 1976: 1-color block print; calligraphy designs. various colors. Joy: I'd met Liv.
- 1977: 1-color block print.
- 1977: xerographic copy wedding announcement: we got married in mid-Dec.
- 1978: 2-color block-print, 1st as married couple. featured Norwegian-style woven heart-baskets. paper heart-baskets included in with the cards.
- 1979: we moved to California. xerographic copy of drawing of our new living room
- 1980: Lewis was born: 3rd sock shown on mantle-piece. xerographic copy
- 1981: Lewis as a toddler. xerographic copy; various colors for paper.
- 1982: stenciled design outside, xerographic copy inside. Based on skills taught at VPA (Victorian Preservation Assoc., "the old house club").
- 1983: stencil and xerographic copy.
- 1984: balloon: first attempt at silkscreening, using cut-out masks.
- 1984: my first silkscreened Christmas card. 3 colors outside + 1 color inside.
   Note the 5th "L": Leif was on the way!

### 1985 - 1998

- 1985: my father's 80th birthday. Xerox w/ gold silkscreen.
- 1985: 3-color silkscreen outside + 1 color inside. Our persimmon tree.
- 1986: 3-color silkscreen of calligraphy.
- 1987: 3-color silkscreen on xerographic copy. Inside, made star-design of monogram.
- 1988: 4-color silkscreen. Note: only had 5x7" screen, so had to "splice" design to fit on page: the tree is made of two colors of brown.
- 1989: 5-color silkscreen. First original done on computer, for better color registration: previous designs had been hand-drawn.
- 1990: 4-color silkscreen. First picture with a cat.
- 1991: 4-color silkscreen. "Virtual reality": room, tree, rug were laid out in AutoCad and rendered in perspective. Cat (Chip) was scanned & added afterwards.
- 1992: 3-color silkscreen (getting lazy!). Liv started quilting class, hence motive.
  Hidden joke: Lockheed was doing severe downsizing, hence the "No 'L".
- 1993: 4-color silkscreen. Cross between 12-Days song, "Partridge in a pear tree", and our prickly pear cactus, which was becoming prominent.
- 1994: computer print-out w/ family cameos.
- 1995: 4-color silkscreen, inside and out. Design honors our tree-planting project
- 1996: this silkscreen print uses only 3-colors: my first gradient print. front & inside done at the same time.
- 1997: 3-color silkscreen: honoring Lewis and his garage band.
- 1998: photo-shopped computer prints of photographs.

### 1999 - 2012

- 1999: 4-color silkscreen. This one was harder than it looked: I couldn't find oilbased black ink, and the water-based ink dissolved the screen mask.
- 2000: 3-pass silkscreen: red; blue/green dual ink; and pink/blue/turquoise gradient, made of acrylic ink that gummed up the screen: many touch-ups needed.)
- 2001: 2-color silkscreen on xerographic print. Done in PowerPoint, also presented as an animation w/ sound-effects. Honors all kids driving.
- 2002: 4-color silkscreen: Chip the cat eyeing the suite of nut-crackers
- 4-color silkscreen: meant to look like a video game. Leif and his repaired VW bus, Logan and his games, Lewis w/ music, Liv got her US Citizenship, I bike and play with satellites.
- 2004: 4-color silkscreen: our street + computer print on inside.
- 2005: 4-color silkscreen + computer print on inside: kids off at work or school
- 2006: 2-color silkscreen + computer print (calligraphy by PowerPoint: Bezier curves!): Norway trip + bike ride to LA
- 2007: 4-color silkscreen: frenetic year. computer print inside.
- 2008: 4-color silkscreen (sunflowers) + computer print on inside.
- 2009: 3-color silkscreen (grey, charcoal, and blue-red gradient)
   + computer print on inside. the view from our kitchen window
- 2010: 3-color silkscreen. Inside: blank
- 2011: outside: laser-cut by Leif from PowerPoint Bezier curves. Inner insert: silkscreened and aligned so as to be behind front cuts. Back: laser-cut
- 2012: 4-color silkscreen (Napa Valley vineyards) + computer print on inside

### 2013 - 2024

- 2013: 5-color silkscreen: busy year (Buenos Aires, trestle, Denmark & Norway), flowing towards chaos (retirement? lay-off?)
- 2014: 4-color silkscreen (Christmas under the stars in our backyard) + silkscreened greeting & signatures inside
- 2015: 4-color silkscreen ("Jules" & the year's events in letter-blocks) + computer-print inside
- 2016: 4-color silkscreen (bathroom remodel shower wall) + computer-print inside
- 2017: 5-color silkscreen (it took 4 tries to print the gold!): "Four Seasons"
   (the year's travels), spanned by the trestle. Inside: blank
- 2018: 3-color silkscreen front (attempts at gradients in the rosemaling failed...)
   on black paper; 1-color inside w/ sparkle glitter.
- 2019: 3-color silkscreen: the year's travels: India (elephant) + Barcelona Spain (Picasso's eyes) + Norway (baskets) + Redwoods (red trunk); 1-color inside.
- 2020: "rerun": 1-color silkscreen (based on 1972 design); 1-color inside (1982 calligraphy & 2019 signature); 1978 woven paper heart basket -in remembrance of Liv's passing.
- 2021: 2-pass silkscreen: red/peach/green gradient & blue/purple/red. inside blank
- 2022: 2-color silkscreen, traced from photos of MidEast trip. Hieroglyphics inside.
- 2023: 4-color silkscreen, from photos. Printed extra copies for a club's fundraiser.
- 2024: 2-color silkscreen: light-hearted in dark times, w/ solar eclipse. Inside blank.
